Results and Discussion

This section may be divided into subsections (Results and discussions separately) or may be combined.

Conclusions

This should clearly explain the main conclusions of the article, highlighting its importance and relevance.

Conflicts of Interest

Authors must declare all relevant interests that could be perceived as conflicting. If no conflicts exist, the authors should state as Submitting authors are responsible for co-authors declaring their interests.

Funding Statement

Authors must state how the research and publication of their article was funded, by naming financially supporting

If the research did not receive specific funding, please mention as self-funded by all the authors Acknowledgments

All acknowledgments (if any) should be included at the very end of the manuscript before the references. Anyone who contributed to the research or manuscript, but who is not a listed author, should be acknowledged (with their permission).

References

References must follow Vancouver style and be cited numerically in the order they appear in the text. Ensure all references are accurate, complete, and cited in the manuscript. Examples:

- 1. Author(s). Title of the article. Abbreviated Journal Name. Year; Volume (Issue): Pages.
- 2. Author(s). Book Title: Edition. Place of publication: Publisher; Year.
